Play Ready Golf

1. Play shall not exceed four hours
 2. Hit when you are ready even if you are not away
 3. If someone in your group is searching for his ball go ahead and hit, then help him look
 4. Always have a second ball on hand in case a provisional ball is needed
 5. If in a cart, always carry a couple of clubs with you to prevent the need to return to your cart
 6. Record all scores and place clubs back in your bag at the next tee box
 7. As the cart driver, drop your playing partner off at their ball and then immediately drive to your ball
 8. If playing mixed golf, ladies should ride together and gentlemen should ride together
 9. Never lose sight of the group in front of you
- Remember, if you are playing slowly you are not just holding up the group behind you, you may be backing up the whole course

“Mine, and One More”

If we will all take a little “ownership” of our course, and take a few seconds to repair just one additional divot, one more ball mark, then we can help make LBS even more enjoyable for everyone

Bunkers

1. Begin your raking by raking the divot from which you hit your ball, then your footprints. Pull the tines of the rake toward you to smooth over the sand without pulling too much sand. Attempt to restore the average surface of the sand to the proper contours of the bunker. Walk backwards towards your entry point, cleaning up your footprints as you go
2. All rakes should be left in the bunkers

Dress Code

1. Acceptable attire will include: a collared shirt with sleeves, mock turtlenecks, long or short sleeved and tailored slacks or shorts
2. Women may wear acceptable length tailored shorts, slacks, skirts and capris
3. Unacceptable attire shall include, but is not limited to: tee shirts, swim suits, sweat shirts, running shorts, gym shorts, blue jeans, cut off pants, tank tops and halter tops. Each golfer must wear soft spikes or soft soled athletic shoes
4. NO BLUE JEANS on the course

2017 GOLF RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations are set forth to provide an enjoyable golf experience for all golfers at Lake Barrington Shores Golf Club. It is expected that all golfers, members and guests, shall be subject to and abide by the following rules:

1. USGA Rules of Golf will govern all play except when modified by local rules. The Golf Professional and the professional staff will determine the rules and regulations of all Club events.
2. The Golf Professional Staff shall have full authority to regulate play on the golf course at all times.
3. The Golf Course Superintendent, or in his/her absence, the Golf Professional, shall have full authority to restrict or prohibit play due to weather, course conditions or general maintenance.
4. Pace of play shall not exceed four hours. If a complete hole is open ahead of a group, Golf Staff will ask the group to exercise one of the following options: (1) close the gap and maintain that position, (2) step aside and let the faster groups play through before resuming play, (3) If a group is unable to keep up with the normal pace of play, they will be asked to leave the golf course and any fees collected will be refunded on a pro-rated basis.
5. Practice will be limited to designated areas only.
6. All players, members and guests must check-in and register in the Golf Shop before beginning play.
7. All play must begin play from the #1 tee unless otherwise authorized by the Golf Professional Staff.
8. Players who stop at the Oasis may forfeit their position on #10 tee if there is a delay.
9. Each player playing golf shall be equipped with a set of golf clubs and dressed in acceptable golf attire. Acceptable attire will include: a collared shirt with sleeves, mock turtlenecks, long or short sleeved and tailored slacks or shorts. Women may wear acceptable length tailored shorts, slacks, skirts and capris. Unacceptable attire shall include, but is not limited to: tee shirts, swim suits, sweat shirts, running shorts, gym shorts, blue jeans, cut off pants, tank tops and halter tops. Each golfer must wear soft spikes or soft soled athletic shoes.
10. Starting times are required for all players. Tee times may be reserved two weeks in advance and will require the names of each player. Golfers who arrive late for their assigned tee time will be given the next available time.
11. For safety purposes and the general consideration of all golfers, children will not be allowed on the golf course, unless they are playing golf under the supervision of an adult.
12. The Golf Professional Staff shall be utilized, as needed, to expedite play, to enforce golf etiquette and general golf rules and regulations. It is the obligation of each golfer to comply with these directions.
13. Scheduled Club events have priority over all other play on the golf course.
14. Only food and beverage provided by the Club is permitted on the golf course. It is against Club policies to bring coolers on Club property.
15. Pets are not permitted on the golf course.
16. Walking, jogging, or bicycling is not permitted on the golf course.
17. Offensive language or actions will not be tolerated and may result in suspension of a member's club use and playing privileges.
18. The Club shall not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to any property of any kind belonging to members or their guests.
19. Inclement Weather – Play of five (5) holes or more constitutes a nine (9) hole round; play of thirteen (13) holes or more constitutes an eighteen (18) hole round.
20. Golf Carts must remain on the cart paths around all tees and greens. The Professional Staff shall have full authority to suspend playing privileges for failing to adhere to this rule.
21. Golf carts are provided for the convenience of those registered to play golf.
22. To drive a golf cart, a person must be 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license.
23. Golfers using electric golf carts are responsible for any damages to the cart while it is in their use and will be required to pay for such damages. Lake Barrington Shores Golf Club is not liable for any personal injury or property damage that may occur as a result of electric cart usage.
24. Failure to observe and obey cart rules and regulations may result in the forfeiture of their use.
25. A guest is an individual who is accompanied by a golf member for the purpose of playing golf or using the Club facilities. A guest is subject to guest green fees for 18 or 9 holes. Each individual guest is limited to four (4) rounds of golf per calendar year.
26. Lake Barrington Shores resident may play four (4) times per calendar year as a guest and pay the appropriate green fee.
27. Members of the PGA and LPGA may be granted playing privileges with approval of the Head Golf Professional.
28. The 2017 season begins 04/11/2017 and ends 11/12/2017.
29. The Club reserves the authority to close the course.
30. All food and services must be paid for when rendered.
31. Reciprocal billing will have a 10% service charge.
